We are Disability Positive.

We got £4.2 million to run our services.

We spent £4.08 million.

We had a little extra money left over: £118,000.

We helped over 10,000 people.






98 out of 100 people said they were happy with our help.

## **Speaking Up**

We helped 312 people speak up and we made sure their rights were respected.

570 people joined our community groups.



603 people got help to take part in activities.

People felt less lonely, more confident, and more independent.

We helped 12 employers make workplaces better for disabled people.



We offered volunteering opportunities.
